Swedish church records are a gem for researching your Swedish family history. But obstacles do occur. Sometimes, the ministers would use abbreviations or record notes in the *comments* column in the household record. What do these notes and abbreviations mean? Sometimes the minister did not note the birthplace in the household book. Where is the birth record? Sometimes we lose a person, and we can't trace him backward or forward? Is it possible to find this person? In the presentation, we will look at some case studies highlighting stumbling blocks researchers have experienced over the years and present strategies and solutions.
