

**SPRINT Grant 2023 –  
West Kentuck School House  
Scope of Work**

**Building Description:** One of the original 123 one room country schools of McPherson County. One of very few remaining one room schools in our county. Represents District #69, organized in 1874. Original location near what is now the interstate rest area between Lindsborg and McPherson. Among the last group of schools to consolidate, it closed in 1952. Donated to the museum by the Mingenback family when it was threatened by interstate construction.

**Project Description:**

Re-paint exterior of building.

**Detail of Work:**

- Scrape peeling / chipping paint Handscraping or soft washing only – no power washing
- Prime bare wood
- Caulk cracks as necessary
- Fill holes as necessary
- Paint to be used – Sherwin Williams Emerald

**General Conditions:**

- Certificate of insurance is required
- Storage and handling of all materials must be in a manner which prevents additional loss, deterioration, and damage; storage area to be designated by project administrator.
- Construction schedule to be itemized with headings related to the breakdown in payment requests.
- Compliance with all applicable laws and statutory regulations is required.
